- DIARRHEA
- VOMITING
- THICK/STICKY SALIVA



#### WHAT TO DO:



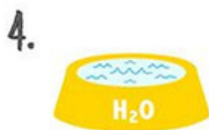
1. Move dog into a cool area



2. Apply cool water all over body



3. Apply cool towels to head, neck and chest



4. Give small drinks of cool water



5. Take your dog to the vet ASAP
