

VOLUNTEER MEETING NOVEMBER 16TH, 2022

COMMITTEE UPDATES

- CAFÉ (Companion Animal Food Effort) / Sheila Lund:
 - Demand is picking up.
 - 2 ½ 3 pallets of food will be picked up later this week. Thank you to Jeff, Mark, Tim, and Cindy for helping out.
- SAFE (Saving Animals through Focused Education / Dawn Espinosa:
 - Dawn will be meeting with Beth Lamb in the near future to discuss the future of SAFE. In the meantime,
 still working to get SAFE information added to the website.
- NAF (Noah's Animal Fund) / Christina Zink:
 - o NAF assisted the families of Luca and Mariah in October for a total of \$4310.76.
 - To date, \$25726.31 has been paid out on behalf of owners who qualify for financial hardship. NAF has committed to paying out an additional \$3000 (currently waiting for an invoice).
 - NAF has received several 'bigger ticket' (ortho surgeries) applications this year. Typically, NAF allows a
 max of \$3000 and usually does not cover more than 60% of the vet fees. However, each application is
 reviewed on a case-by-case basis.
 - A recent NAF recipient stopped by the Meat Raffle on Saturday to thank FON and donate.
 - Sue Showers mentioned that a former NAF recipient is now a foster it is her way of giving back to FON.

ANIMAL UPDATE

- Cat Update / Cindy Jenson:
 - o Adoptions are slower at the moment.
 - Bella & Beatrice (senior bonded pair) just adopted.
 - Hershey (now Willow) which was a return is doing very well in its new home.
 - There is currently an abundance of kittens! Foster Jessica Cullen saved them from becoming ferals.
 - o Cindy has just taken in a Mama and 4 kittens (there were 5, one died from the cold).
- Dog Update / Sue Showers:
 - o Dumped beagles Bailey and Sidney were adopted by their foster.
 - Puppies: Harper has been adopted by her foster. Nova is available for adoption and is already receiving lots of applications. FON will be taking in another puppy from the 'oops litter'.
 - o Stray Arthur, who tested positive for Lymes, has been adopted by his foster.
 - o KC (rehome) is currently also in foster care.

TREASURERS REPORT / Christina Zink:

• During October, \$625 in donations and \$695 in adoption fees were received. There was \$705 in foster vet fees and \$4310.76 in NAF vet fees.

- Great job to Debbie Hess for her work on the Sneakers Meat Raffle. Friends of Noah raised a total of \$2144!
 The breakdown was \$715 (from the meat raffle), \$1095 (raffle baskets), \$250 (50/50), and \$84 (donations).
 Sneakers donated the meat.
- Network for Good will be sending \$380 (received in November) for money raised through Facebook. This was for Holly's surgery. Cindy indicated that Holly is now 4 pounds and will be having surgery soon.

- Humane Holidays at Mounds will run 12/1 12/24. This is a food drive for the CAFÉ Program. We will have volunteers on hand from 12-2 on weekends during the event. Donations can be brought into Mounds and left in the 'bin' at the front of the store, purchased in-store and dropped in the bin, or purchased at the register.
