COMMITTEE UPDATES:

CAFE (Companion Animal Food Effort): Shiela Lund reported:

- Our relationship with Petco has changed due to some changes they have recently put in place. We are currently in the process of re-establishing ourselves as one of their Partners with the PetcoLove Foundation. Once this has been re-established, we will need a volunteer(s) for an information table/adoption event at their Janesville location once or twice a month.
- Mounds recently provided a very generous donation to the CAFE Food Pantry. Thank you to Mounds for the donation and to Jeff Hess for help in transporting!
- Marling Lumber/Homeworks recently transported a large amount of food for the CAFE program. Thank you, Marling!

NAF (Noah's Animal Fund): Steve Caya reported:

NAF has been very active in providing financial support to at least 1 or 2 animals on a monthly basis. In some cases, NAF provides a small amount of assistance. In other cases, NAF foots the entire veterinary bill. Applicants need to meet qualifying criteria to be considered for assistance.

- 5 animals have been adopted in the last month (Penny, Liam, Benny, Luca, and Lexi).
- Cooper and Gulliver have been returned to FON and are available for adoption.
- FON recently took in 15 kittens who were rescued from a kill shelter. They will receive the necessary care before being put up for adoption.

- Lexi (recently adopted) has brought life back to the family who adopted her.
- Sassy is doing well and will be up for adoption soon.
- Will be 'out of commission' for a period of time as she recuperates from knee surgery. Rhonda and Emily (Dykstra) will field calls in the interim.
